Biography

Pablo Picasso was born in Malaga, Spain, 1881. One of the greatest and most influential artists of the 20th century, he studied under his father, then went to the Academy of Arts for one year. In 1901 he moved to Paris, which he found as the ideal place to practice new styles, and experiment with a variety of art forms. It was during these initial visits, when he began his work in the surrealism and the cubism style which he was the founder of,and he created many distinct pieces which were influenced by this.

Career



Pablo Picasso was a pacifist, and large scale paintings he created, showcased this cry for peace. After the German bombing of Guernica, he painted The Guernica which shows the brutality of war and death. Pablo Picasso produced a painting unlike anything he or anyone else had ever painted before, a work that would profoundly influence the direction of art in the 20th century.

Picasso's Masterpieces and Awards

In 1962, Pablo Picasso was awarded the Lenin Peace Prize. it is a great accomplishment. The Lenin Peace Prize is considered to be the equivalent to the Nobel Peace Prize
